## Cleaning glass & Framing






1: always remove most dirt with a clean cloth first



2: clean the glass with an appropriate neutral product (e.g. Instanet) or with warm water with a splash of vinegar (to degrease)



**3:** or with very fine steel wool 000 to remove difficult stains



**4:** and if necessary, brush off with hand brush or duster or blow off the remaining dust particles



**5:** dust off the back (dust particles may stick to the sides )



6: dust off the rebate of the frame




7: put the back on the worktable and position the picture to be framed on the back



8: put the glass on the picture, so that you can see if there are no dust particles left behind the glass and if the glass is clean



9: put the frame on top of it



**10:** only if all parts are assembled, turn the whole









11: fasten the back to the frame with leafsprings, turnbuttons, flexitabs or nails
